Actividades realizadas durante el ciclo escolar

1. Field Trip

In March a trip to Florence was taken where rallies, games held in groups, and competitions were played in the park and at the end the winners were awarded with a trophy celebration.

2. Mothers Day Celebration

May is the month where they celebrate Mother's Day, where students contribute the refreshments and they are the protagonists of the entire program this is being conducted. They perform activities involving their mothers in songs, poems, drama etc

3. PROYECTO DE INTECAP.

One of the most important achievements this year is that they managed to make a covenant with INTECAP (Instituto Técnico de Capacitación y Productividad) of the State of Guatemala for young people to receive computer courses certified by the State and which helps young people to have better job opportunities.

Three groups of students for the training course were formed as follows :

- Daily Plan 20 students.
- Saturday school 20 students
- Sunday school 20 students

Out of the 60 students 55 passed the course and received accredited diplomas.

Another group of 20 students are being currently trained to reach the level of expertise on Saturdays from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and will end in December. Unfortunately our digital projector has been ruined because of daily use, and the last one we had we fixed but are afraid that it will not last until the end of the year. At the beginning of the year we took some funds from Cafnima to buy the

correct equipment for the students to use since they have made great achievement in this area and have been working hard to deserve the correct environment.

4. Teachers Day

It was held by the educational coordinator, Delfina and students, from each grade prepared snacks and activities in each classroom with their teacher's guidance.

5. Workshops and Lectures

We have a person who has been supporting us since July in the area of counseling and psychology. Delia Zthay is a person very dear to her students, they have the confidence to tell her their problems and search for emotional support. They have shared in each grade topics such as:
